But college expenses are on the rise. At Colorado State University, room and board and tuition for a Colorado resident can cost between \$23,000 and \$27,000 *per year*. Through this year's Missions Fund, we're hoping to raise \$8,000 in dorm scholarships for students in Summitview's college ministry who want to be a faithful presence on the CSU campus.
