Discussion Questions

Before starting discussion, read through 1 Corinthians 12.

1. Consider your top three reasons for attending church. Do they include the fact that your local church body really needs you? What things make this hard for you to believe?
2. Considering the giant redwood trees, how interlocking are your “roots” with other believers at Summitview? If not ideal, why is that? (Is it a gospel issue, a priority issue, an insecurity issue, a self-sufficiency issue, an availability issue, a character issue - i.e. laziness, apathy - or something else?) What is your next step toward deeper connection?
3. How have you been blessed by intergenerational ministry? What spoke to you most in Buck’s testimony, and how might you apply it in your life?
4. Read 1 Peter 4:8-10. How is God calling you to shine this week and beyond? What gifts has he given you to steward?
