## THE GOD OF COMFORT discussion questions

1. Paul was likely feeling discouraged when he arrived at Corinth. What contributed to this discouragement? Describe a recent time when you've felt similarly disillusioned or weary and in need of comfort.
2. God often comforts and refreshes through relationships and partnerships. When has he used such a partnership to comfort you? Are there relationships that he is potentially providing for your comfort right now that you haven't taken advantage of like you could? What would it take to better utilize the relational resources he's provided?
3. God also comforts by confirming his presence in our lives. How does he do this? What do we do to receive and experience his presence?
4. God told Paul that he had many people in Corinth. Can you think of a time when God was doing much more than you realized at the time? What are some examples of God producing fruit in your life, but doing it slowly and subtly? When you read Galatians 6:9, what specific situation might you need to apply that promise to?
5. Sometimes God arranges circumstances in a surprising way to provide protection (as he did with Gallio's decision in this passage). When have you received unexpected blessing and protection in a difficult situation?
6. Pray for each other to be comforted in whatever difficult situations are being experienced.
