



Do Justice

1. When you consider hot-button issues like global warming, mandatory vaccines, or immigration policies, on a scale of 1-10, (where 1 represents total pacifism, and 10 represents total activism), where would you say you fall, and why?
2. What stood out to you from the 10/3 teaching on Critical Race Theory? Do you feel like you could adequately explain it to someone else, or would you like to read some of the additional suggested resources?
3. Much of the Old Testament is devoted to teaching God's people, God's standards of justice, in all kinds of situations and scenarios, including how to deal with the poor, the oppressed, widows, orphans, and foreigners. How familiar are you with all that? How is the world trying to meet these needs today? What problems have arisen as a result?
4. Read James 2:1-9. What does God say here about various inequities in the world? What is his instruction to us as believers regarding how to address them?
5. The world's solution to oppression, and the gap between the "haves" and the "have nots" is to forcibly make everyone the same in the areas of income, possessions, education, opportunities, etc., so that there are no longer any distinct "classes". What are some of the benefits and problems of a classless society?
6. Read Matthew 15:19-20. Understanding that the source of mankind's problems are primarily internal rather than external, what do you see as our best hope and strategy for solving racism and other forms of discrimination in our country?
