# Classical Marxism was built on:

- **Materialism** – the belief that physical matter is all that exists.
- **Empiricism** – the belief that all knowledge can only be known through our senses.
- **Positivism** – the belief that science is the foundation of all knowledge.



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- **Relativism** – Subjective feelings determine reality



# Matthew 15:17-20

Do you not see that whatever goes into the mouth passes into the stomach and is expelled? But what comes out of the mouth proceeds **from the heart**, and this defiles a person.



### 3. What are the specific tenets (beliefs) of CRT?

1. The United States was founded on racism, white supremacy, and patriarchy, and those forces are still at the root of our society today. It reformulates the old Marxist dichotomy of oppressor and oppressed, by replacing it with the racial categories of white and black.



### 3. What are the specific tenets (beliefs) of CRT?

2. Racism is everywhere. There is no institution, no conversation, no company where racism does not exist.

Racism is present, even if no one is racist! If you live in the West, that has been built *for* white supremacists and *by* white supremacists, it can only be changed if you blow up the entire thing.



### 3. What are the specific tenets (beliefs) of CRT?

3. It divides people by race, and then tells them that their differences have “no reconciliation and no coming together unless the people that they describe as eternal victims, (black people, people of color, women, transgender people, etc.), unite to destroy and dismantle our existing institutions.

4. It holds that America is fundamentally racist, yet it teaches people to view every social interaction and every person in terms of race!

6. Dialogue is evil.

If you have a discussion with someone you disagree with, you're only validating the incumbent power structure.

They do not believe in a dialectic (*i.e.* the logical discussion of opposing ideas and opinions).






