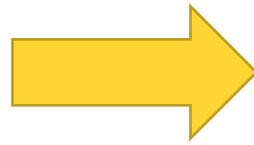

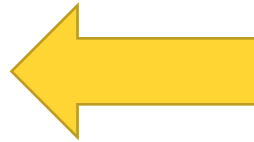

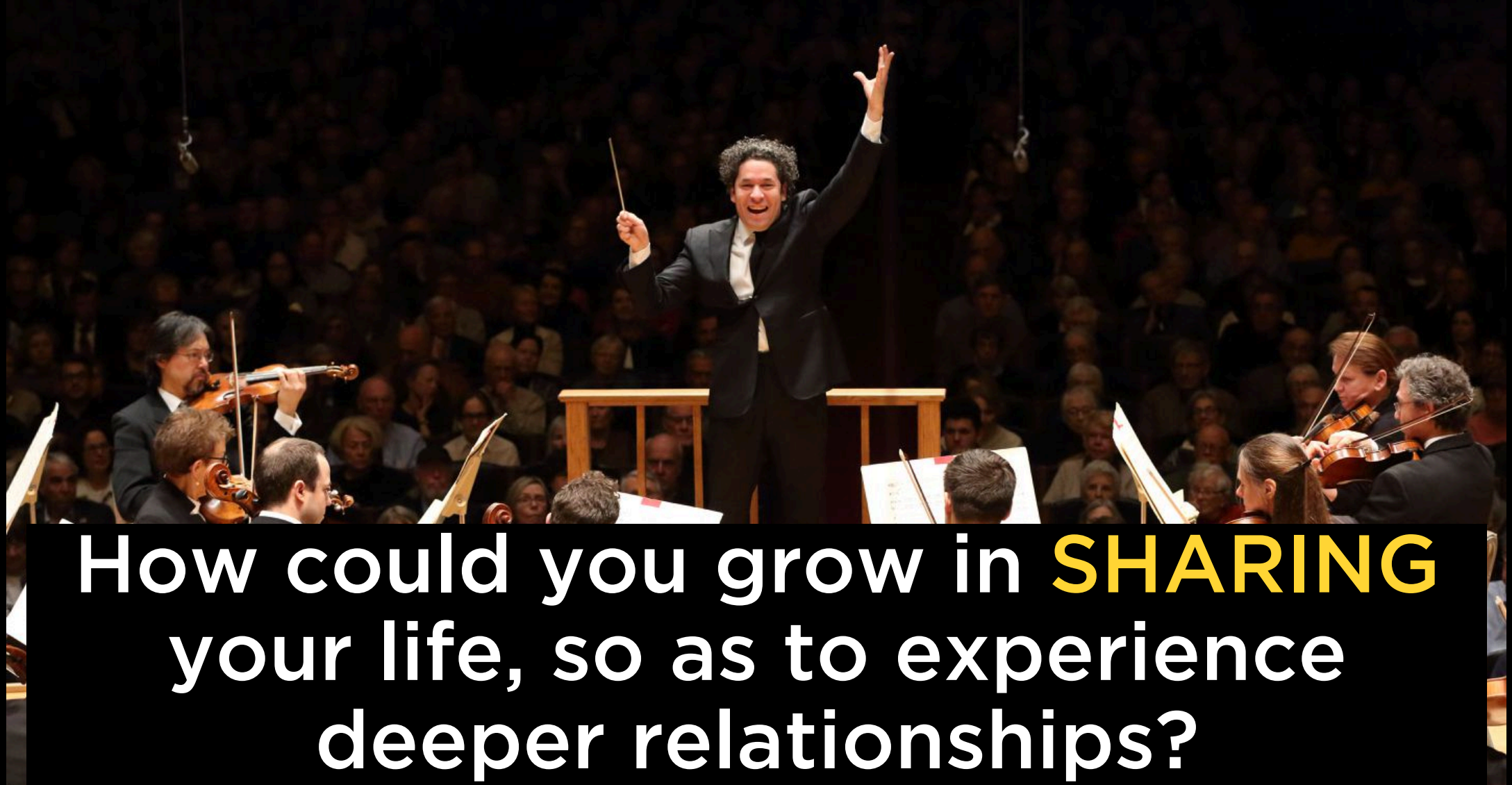

- Like Father: Son's Life & Judgement
- Gospel= Eternal Life + No Judgement
- Son's Life & Judgement authority (Present & Future)

Marvelous Greater works: Life + Judgement

Like Father: Son's Life & Judgement (vs 20-23)

For the Father...has given all judgment to the Son, that all may honor the Son, just as they honor the Father.

Whoever does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who sent him. (John 5:22-23)



Marvelous Greater works: Life + Judgement

Gospel= Eternal Life + No Judgement

Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life.
(John 5:24)



Marvelous Greater works: Life + Judgement

Only on the evidence of two witnesses or of three witnesses shall a charge be established. (Deuteronomy 19:15)

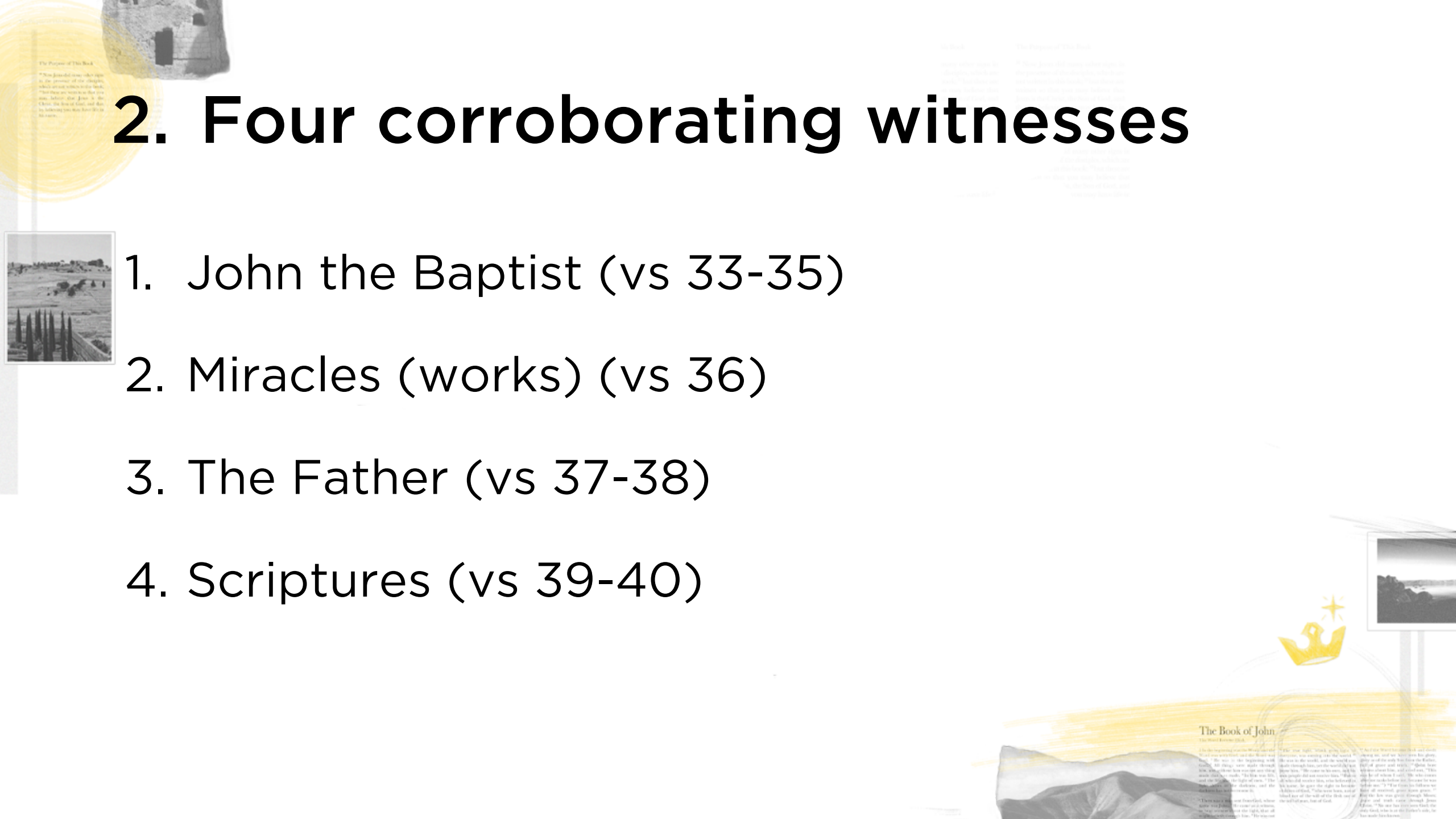
