





3 Different Kinds of Grace Possible

1. Conditional Grace

A progressive grace, that begins with God observing how one responds to general revelation. If one rejects it, then God feels no obligation to give more revelation. But if one accepts it, then God continues to give increasing knowledge of himself.





2. Prevenient Grace

A universal grace given to all, that fully negates the depravity of man, placing man in a neutral state, capable of accepting or rejecting the gospel. The ultimate reason why one person goes to heaven and another doesn't, is because that person chose to believe the gospel, while the other person didn't.



3 Different Kinds of Grace Possible


2. Prevenient Grace

(Another twist on this view, is that hearing the gospel message accomplishes the softening and drawing of some peoples' hearts to Christ. So it's not universally given; it's contingent on hearing the gospel. And even then, it's most oftentimes rejected.)




