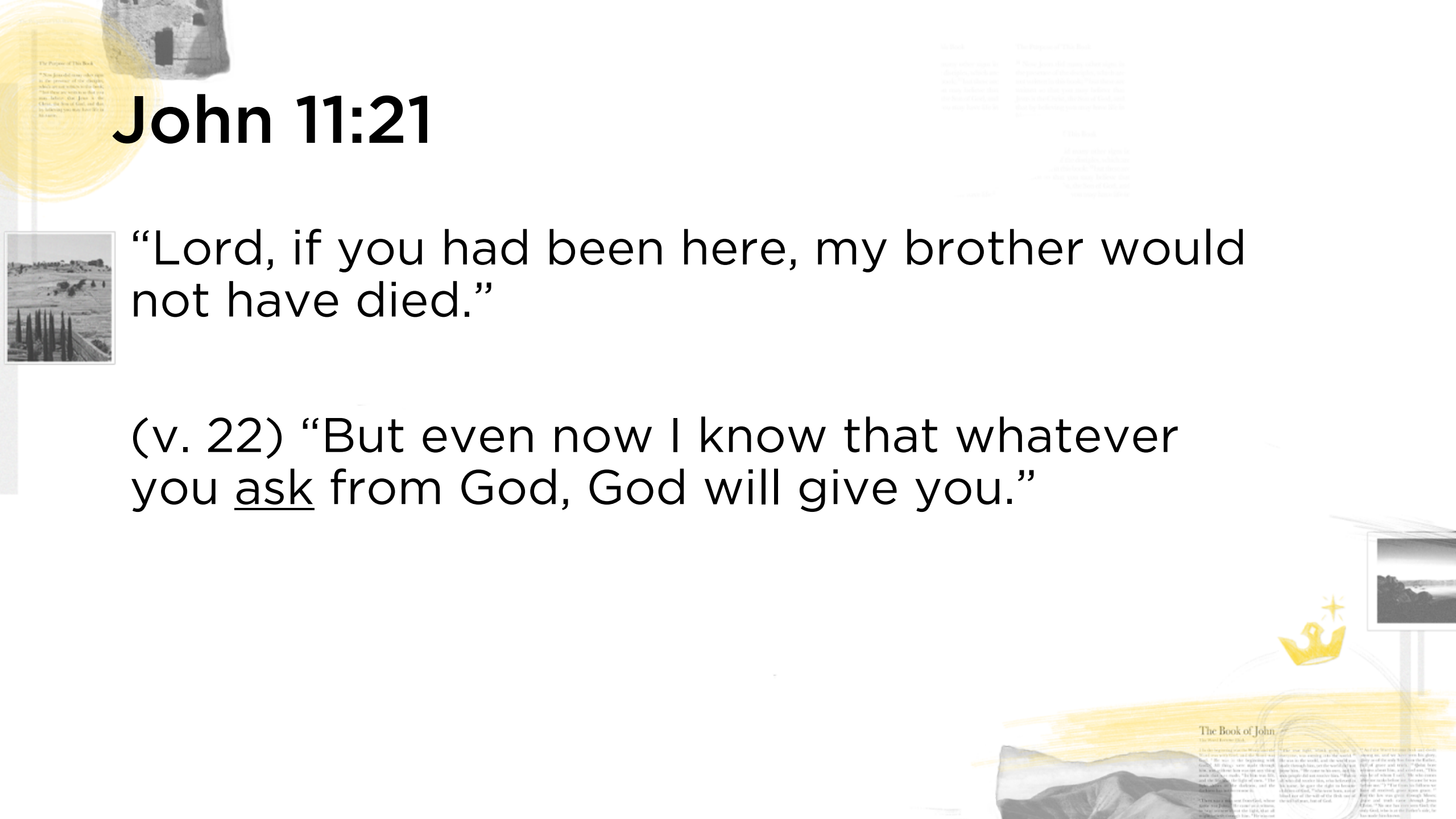



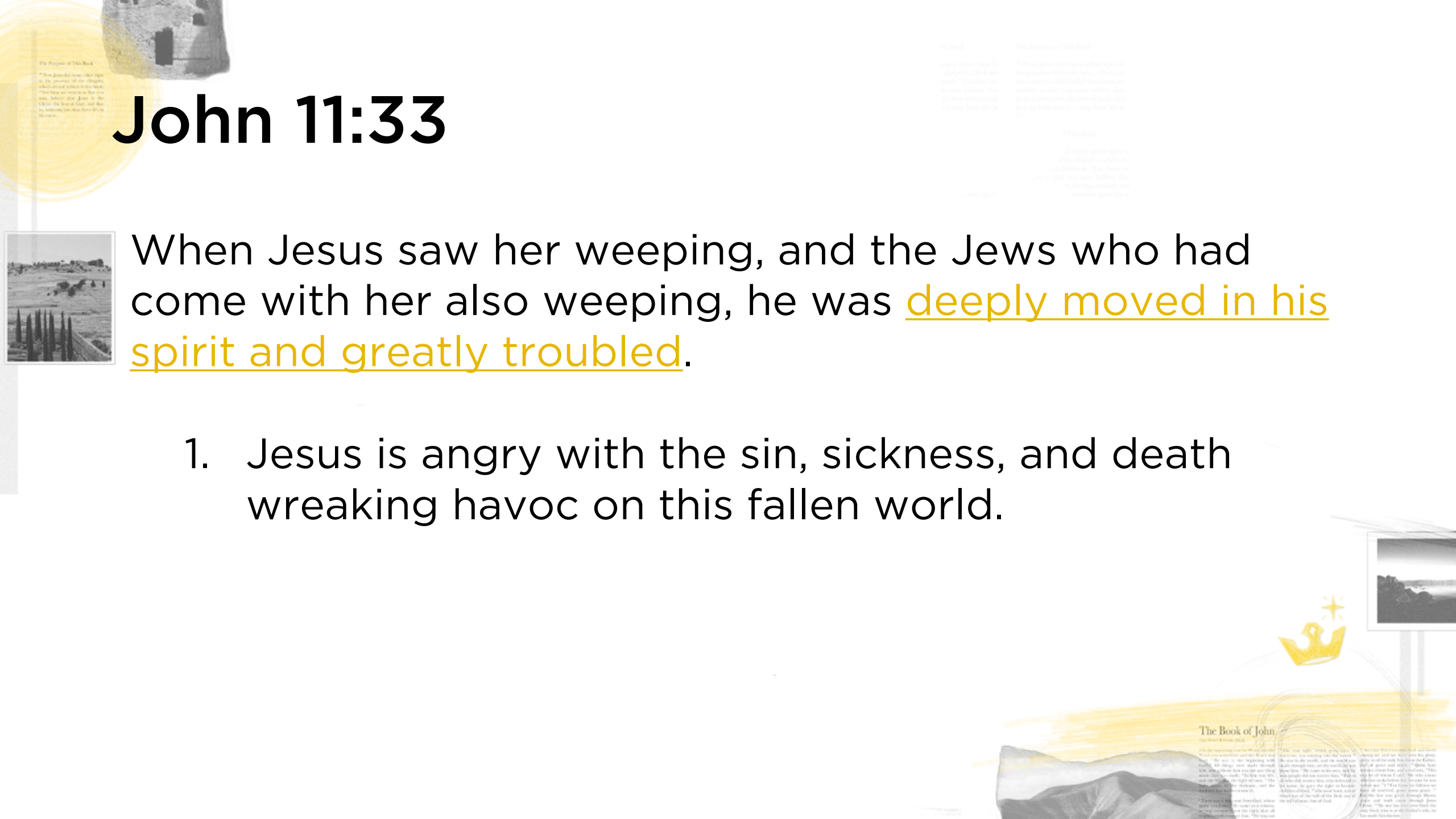

The Purpose of This Book
The purpose of this book is to show that Jesus is the Son of God, who has come into the world to bring life to all who believe in him. This book is written for those who have not yet believed, and for those who have already believed, to strengthen their faith and to show them the glory of God through Jesus Christ.

The Book of John
The Book of John is the last of the four Gospels. It is written by the apostle John, who was one of the twelve apostles of Jesus. The book is divided into four chapters. Chapter 1 is the prologue, which describes the Word as God and as the one who became flesh and dwelt among us. Chapters 2-12 describe the signs and miracles that Jesus performed, and the growing opposition to him. Chapter 13 describes the Last Supper, and the farewell discourse. Chapter 14 describes the promise of the Holy Spirit, and the assurance of eternal life. Chapter 15 describes the vine and the branches, and the love that God has for those who love him. Chapter 16 describes the promise of the resurrection, and the assurance of eternal life. Chapter 17 is the prayer of Jesus for his disciples, and for all who believe in him. Chapter 18 describes the arrest of Jesus, and his trial before the Sanhedrin. Chapter 19 describes the crucifixion, and the burial of Jesus. Chapter 20 describes the resurrection, and the appearance of Jesus to his disciples. Chapter 21 describes the appearance of Jesus to the disciples on the beach, and the promise of the Holy Spirit.
