- 5. Read 2 Corinthians 5:16-21. To what degree do you view yourself as an alien, stranger, and exile in this world, versus a citizen of it? To what degree do you view yourself as sent by Jesus to this world as a minister of reconciliation?
- 6. Take some time to pray for the same things that Jesus prayed in John 17:13-19, and express your personal response to it.
