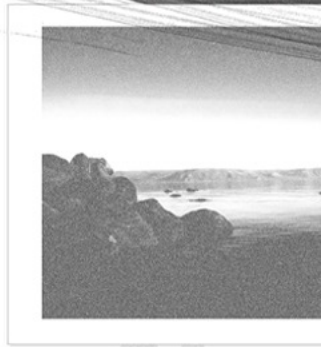
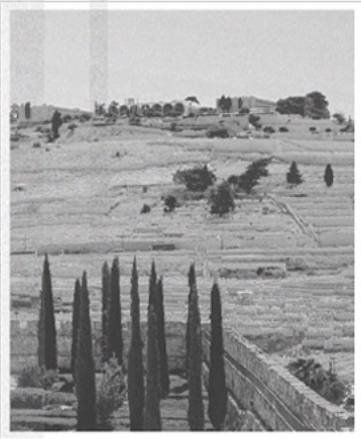
The Word Became Flesh

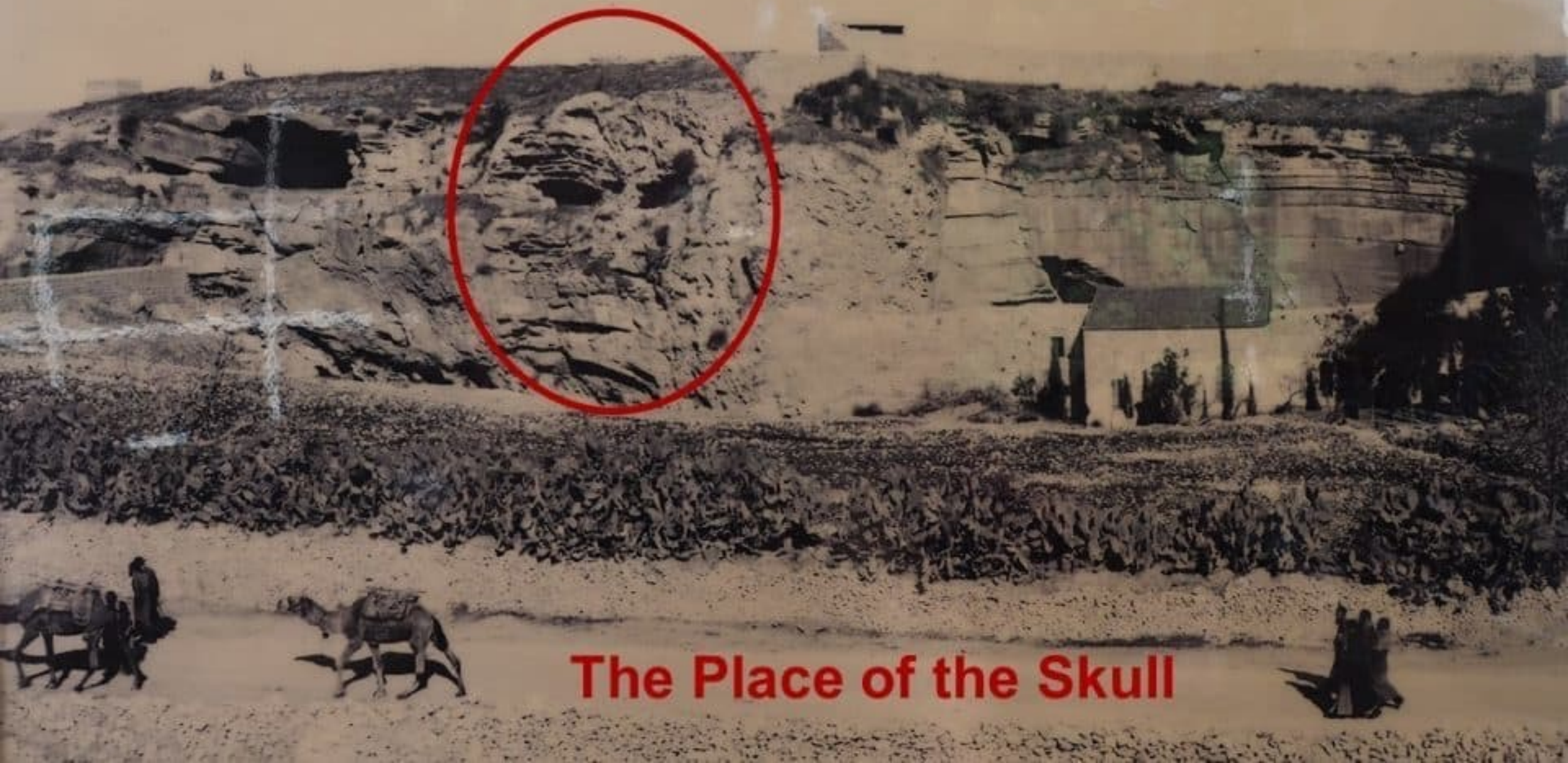
