


"First, among many of those who held the orthodox position, one saw <u>little reality</u> in the things that the Bible so clearly said should be the result of Christianity.

Second, it gradually grew on me that my own reality was less than it had been in the early days after I had become a Christian."





- And it was after 3 days & nights that Jonah emerged from the belly of the great fish, which was the sign that Jesus himself pointed to, in prediction of his own resurrection.






