- 274 AD: the pagan Roman emperor Aurelian declared December 25th to be the birthday of the sun god Sol Invictus
- 350 AD: Pope Julius I declared December 25 to be the official date of Christ's birth
- 529 AD: Emperor Justinian declared Christmas to be a civic holiday.



1. Adoptionism (2nd Century)

This denied the pre-existence of Christ, and therefore <u>denied his Deity</u>. Jesus was adopted as God's son at his baptism, and then into the Godhead after his resurrection.



2. Docetism (2nd Century)

This taught that Jesus only appeared to have a body, and was not truly incarnate, denying his human nature. By denying Jesus truly had a body, they also denied he suffered on the cross and rose from the dead.

3. Apollinarianism (4th Century)

This <u>lessened the human nature of Jesus</u> because it taught that he did not have a human mind, but instead had a mind that was completely Divine.



4. Arianism (4th Century)

This taught that Jesus was a "creature" who was "begotten" of the Father, thus denying his divine nature.



5. Nestorianism (5th Century)

This taught that Jesus was really two separate persons, denying the union of his two natures. Jesus was not God incarnate in the womb, but only until after he was born.



6. Eutychianism (5th Century)

This taught a third nature was possessed by Jesus; a blend or mixture of the human and the Divine, thus denying the distinction of his two natures.



7. Monothelitism (7th Century)


This taught that Jesus had two natures but only one, merged, human/divine will, thus denying the distinction of his two cooperative wills.





"We Christians should know that if God is not in the scale to give it weight, we, on our side, sink to the ground.




