

## Week 2: Money: A Disappointing god Discussion Questions

- 1. What stood out to you most from this passage/sermon?
- 2. Read 1 Timothy 6:6-10 & 17-19 and discuss the following:
  - a. Verse 6 commands "godliness with contentment". What practical steps can we take to build contentment/gratitude?
  - b. Verses 9-10 describe how a love for money leads to a destroyed life and faith. What life examples have you seen of this that serve as a warning?
  - c. Verses 17-19, address the rich. Do you consider yourself rich? What commands stand out to you as particularly applicable to your own situation?
- 3. Love of money is oftentimes expressed in either materialism or anxiety. Which do you struggle with more currently?
- 4. John shared a personal story that anchored in deeper confidence in God's provision. Share your own stories to strengthen one another's faith!
- 5. Debt or overspent budgets can oftentimes be a signal of an area we're asking money to be our god instead of our Heavenly Father. If applicable, would you be willing to confess one of those areas as a first step? Would you consider taking the upcoming Finance Class?
- 6. Counteract financial worry by speaking/praying the gospel truths of Matthew 6:24-34 over one another!
