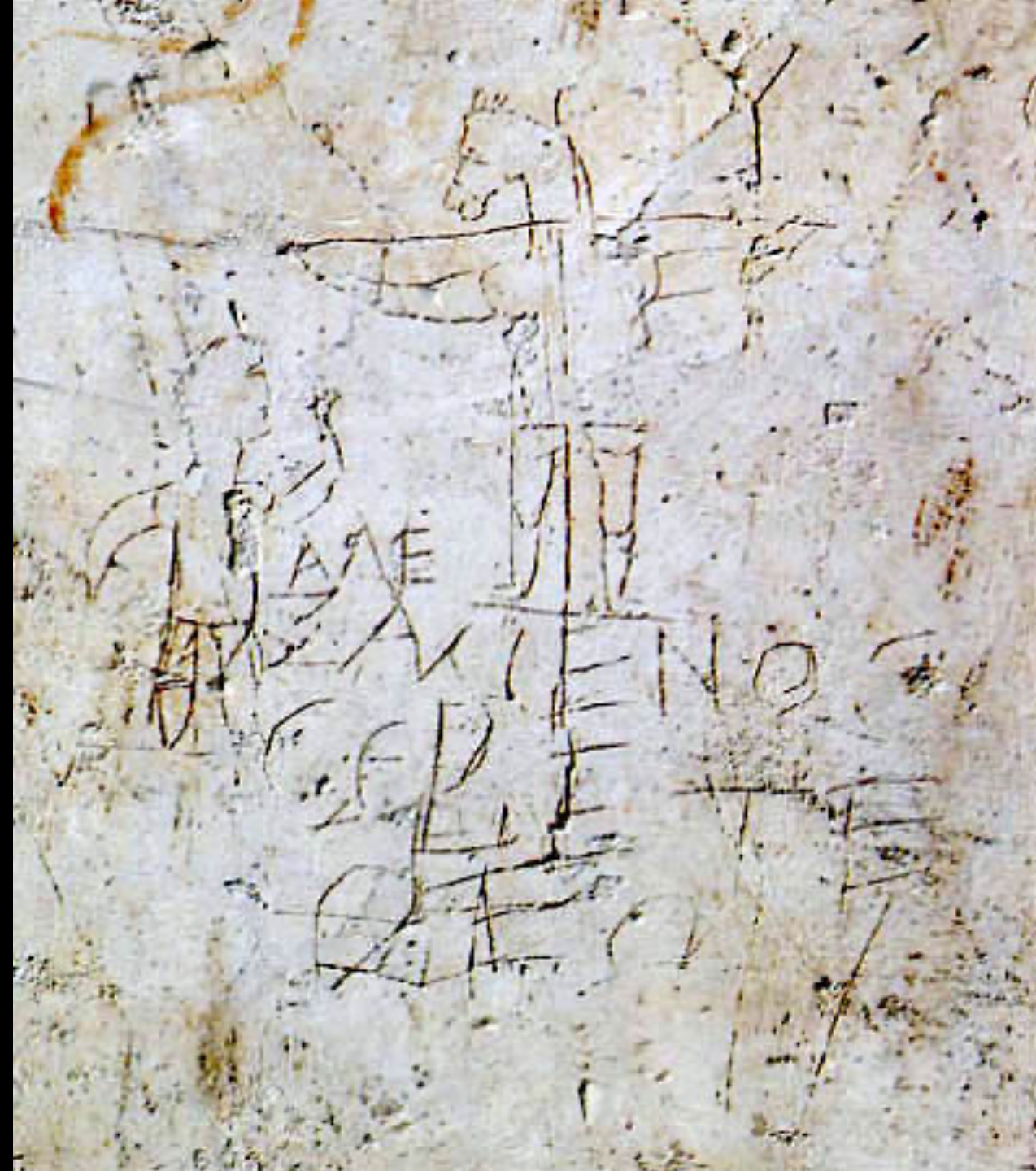


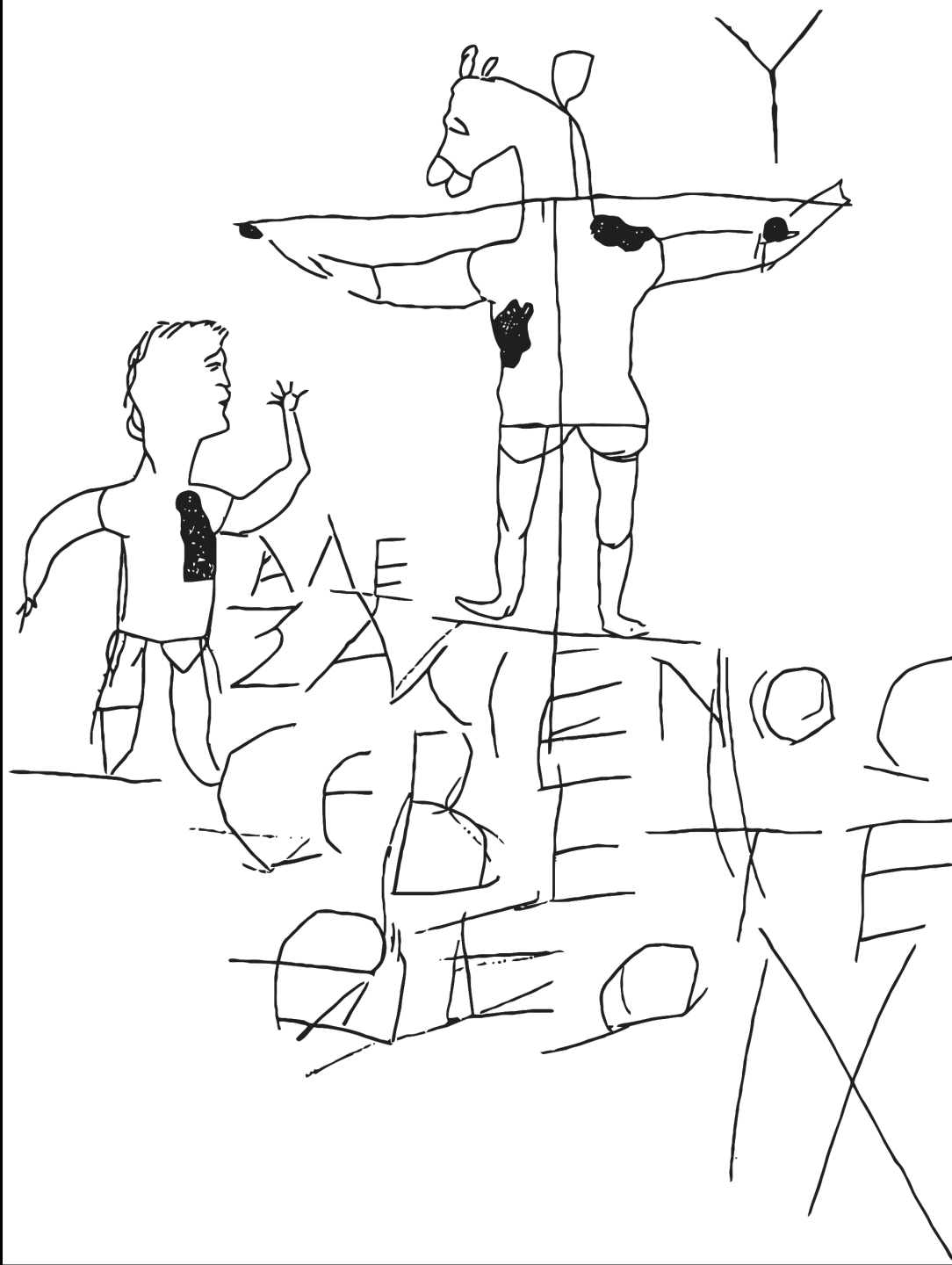

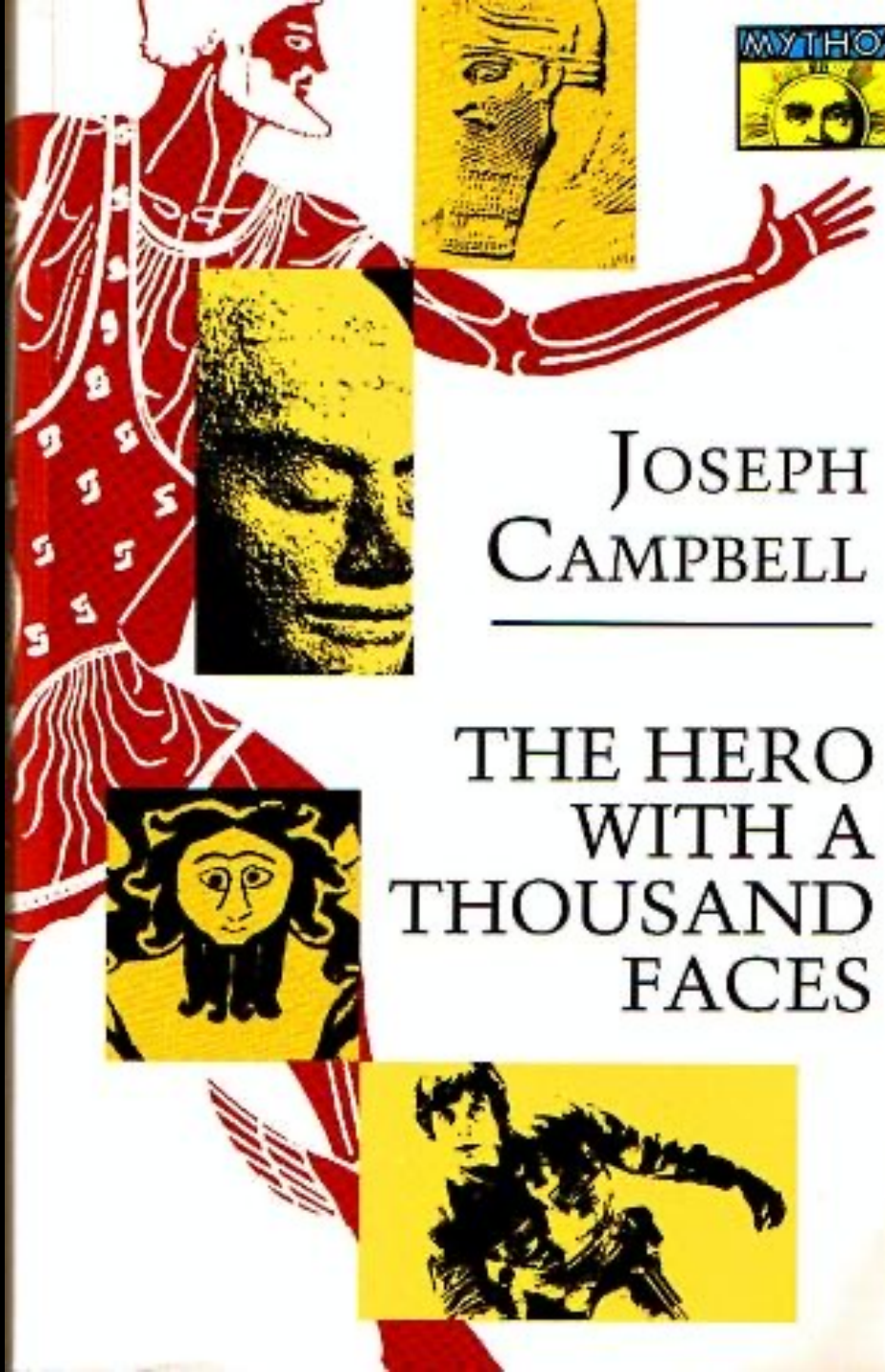
# Zechariah 9:9
