


"Concluding Exhortations"

Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray. Is anyone cheerful? Let him sing praise...


Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray. Is anyone cheerful? Let him sing-praise...


And his disciples asked [Jesus], "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?" (John 9:2)








Paralytic




Some in Corinth

Whoever, therefore, eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty...That is why many of you are weak and ill, and some have died.

1 Corinthians 11:27-30

Sickness is <u>sometimes</u> related to specific sin



James 5:15

...And IF [the one who is sick] has committed sins, he will be forgiven.

Directed toward ordinary Jesus followers

Directed toward ordinary Jesus followers

Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him...

Therefore, [everyone] confess your sins to <u>one</u> <u>another</u> and [everyone] pray for one another, that you may be healed.



Implication: righteous person is a ordinary fellow Jesus follower

Example of powerful healing through ordinary praying person.

Therefore, confess your sins to one another and <u>pray for one another</u>, <u>that you may be healed</u>.

The prayer of a <u>righteous person</u> has <u>great power as it is working</u>.
