The Purpose of the Book of Galatians

It was not written to free non-Christians from their slavery to <u>sin</u>.

It was written to free Christians from their slavery to legalistic Christianity.



Galatians 1:1-10 (Page 972)



Paul, an apostle—not from men nor through man, but through Jesus Christ and God the Father, who raised him from the dead— and all the brothers who are with me,

To the churches of Galatia:

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ, who gave himself for our sins to deliver us from the present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father, to whom be the glory forever and ever. Amen. I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting him who called you in the grace of Christ and are turning to a different gospel— not that there is another one, but there are some who trouble you and want to distort the gospel of Christ.

But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach to you a gospel contrary to the one we preached to you, let him be accursed. As we have said before, so now I say again: If anyone is preaching to you a gospel contrary to the one you received, let him be accursed. For am I now seeking the approval of man, or of God? Or am I trying to please man? If I were still trying to please man, I would not be a servant of Christ.

2 Peter 1:4

Stages of Salvation

God <u>HAS</u> delivered us from the <u>Penalty</u> of sin. (Past) God <u>IS</u> delivering us from the <u>Power</u> of sin. (Present) God <u>WILL</u> deliver us from the <u>Presence</u> of sin. (Future)



Roman Catholicism – Initial justification is by means of baptism [1262-1274]. Salvation is attained by cooperating with grace through faith, good works, and participation in the 7 sacraments. Grace is merited by good works [2010, 2027].



Roman Catholic View of Salvation

Through its seven sacraments, grace is imparted to people, transforming their character so they may work to merit eternal life. <u>The Church affirms</u> <u>that for believers, the sacraments are necessary</u> <u>for salvation</u>. (CCC Para1129)

(Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist, Penance and Reconciliation, Anointing of the Sick, Holy Orders, and Matrimony)

Roman Catholic View of Salvation


Justification is by **faith** (or Latin: *fide*).




