Against the accusations of false teachers, Paul defends before the Galatians his gospel as being from God, not man, with two proofs.



Like the Galatians, we can gain greater confidence that we possess the true gospel by understanding Paul's proofs.




Two proofs Paul didn't preach man's gospel

Transformed life purpose (persecutor → preacher)

2) Years of ministry independent of Jerusalem church





- 1. Paul's pre-conversion life purpose | pre ~34AD | Jerusalem (vs 13-14)
- 2. Conversion + Initial Years | ~34-37AD | Damascus, Arabia, Damascus (vs 15-17)
- 3. 1st Jerusalem Visit |~37 AD for 15 Days| Jerusalem (vs 18-20)
- 4. Ministry in Tarsus +
 Antioch | ~37-45AD |
 Syria & Cilicia (vs 21-24)

Thesis: Not Man's Gospel (vs 11-12)

For I would have you know, brothers, that the gospel that was preached by me is not man's gospel. For I did not receive it from any man, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a revelation of Jesus Christ. (Galatians 1:11-12)

Paul's First Missionary Journey

Thesis: Not Man's Gospel (vs 11-12)

For I would have you know, brothers, that the gospel that was preached by me is not man's gospel. For I did not receive it from any man, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a revelation of Jesus Christ. (Galatians 1:11-12)

Paul's pre-conversion life purpose (vs 13-14)

For you have heard of my former life in Judaism, how I persecuted the church of God violently and tried to destroy it. And I was advancing in Judaism beyond many of my own age among my people, so extremely zealous was I for the traditions of my fathers. (Galatians 1:13-14)



Conversion + Initial Years (vs. 15-17)

But when he who had set me apart before I was born, and who called me by his grace, was pleased to reveal his Son to me, in order that I might preach him among the Gentiles... (Galatians 1:15-16)

Conversion + Initial Years (vs. 15-17)

...I did not immediately consult with anyone; nor did I go up to Jerusalem to those who were apostles before me, but I went away into Arabia, and returned again to Damascus. (Galatians 1:16-17)

1st Jerusalem Visit (vs. 18-20)

Then after three years I went up to Jerusalem to visit Cephas and remained with him fifteen days. But I saw none of the other apostles except James the Lord's brother. (In what I am writing to you, before God, I do not lie!) (Galatians 1:18-20)



Ministry in Tarsus + Antioch (vs. 21-24)

Then I went into the regions of Syria and Cilicia. And I was still unknown in person to the churches of Judea that are in Christ. They only were hearing it said, "He who used to persecute us is now preaching the faith he once tried to destroy." And they glorified God because of me.

(Galatians 1:21-24)

Transformed life purpose (persecutor → preacher)

2) Years of ministry independent of Jerusalem church





Proofs in Galatians 1:15-17

1) Transformed life purpose(persecutor -> preacher)

➤ Paul boldly preaches in Damascus immediately following conversion.

> Threatened with death.

~34**-**37AD



Proofs in Galatians 1:15-17

2) Years of ministry independent of Jerusalem church

➤ Paul doesn't consult with Jerusalem apostles before preaching.

~34-37AD



Proofs in Galatians 1:18-20

1) Transformed life purpose(persecutor -> preacher)

- > Paul boldly preaches in Jerusalem
- > Threatened with death.

~37AD | 15 days



Proofs in Galatians 1:18-20

2) Years of ministry independent of Jerusalem church

- Purpose was to visit Peter
- ➤ Doesn't meet apostles (only Peter & James)
- >Trip was very brief

~37AD | 15 days




Proofs in Galatians 1:21-24

1) Transformed life purpose(persecutor -> preacher)

➤ Paul continues in fruitful gospel ministry for many years!

~37**-**45AD



Proofs in Galatians 1:21-24


2) Years of ministry independent of Jerusalem church
