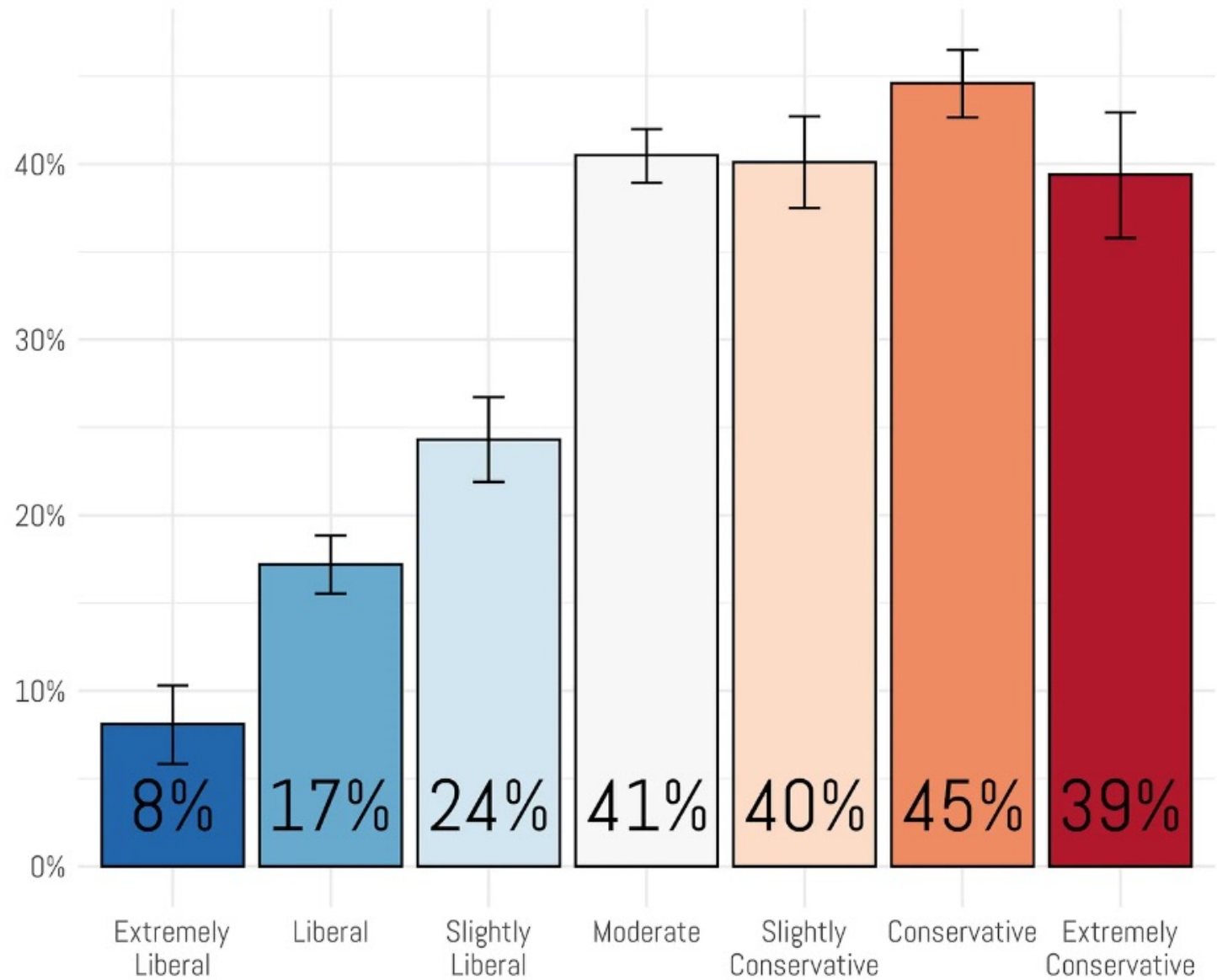

Mark 12:12-17
