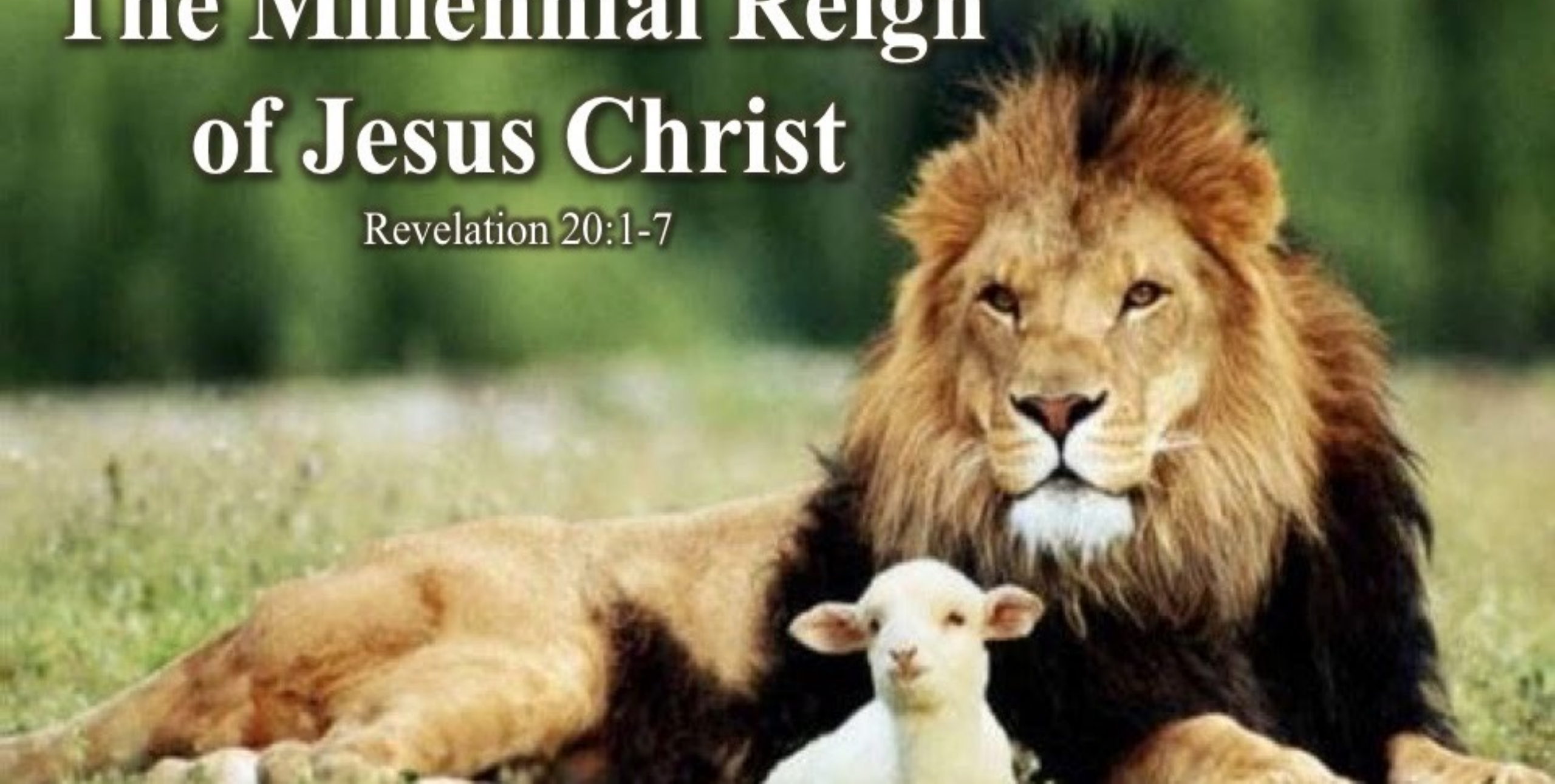

# The Millennial Reign of Jesus Christ

Revelation 20:1-7

laid down by an authority as  
incontrovertibly true.







# Different Views of the Millennium

1. A literal 1,000 year Golden Age of the Jewish nation, after Christ returns: (Dispensational Premillennialism)
2. A Golden Age of Christianity toward the latter part of the Church Age, before Christ returns: (Postmillennialism)
3. The entire Church Age, with Christ reigning from heaven as the gospel goes out to all the earth. (Amillennialism)



## Isaiah 2:1-4

The word that Isaiah the son of Amoz saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem.

It shall come to pass in the latter days that the mountain of the house of the Lord shall be established as the highest of the mountains, and shall be lifted up above the hills; and all the nations shall flow to it, and many peoples shall come, and say:



## Isaiah 2:1-4

“Come, let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, to the house of the God of Jacob, that he may teach us his ways and that we may walk in his paths.”

For out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the Lord from Jerusalem. He shall judge between the nations, and shall decide disputes for many peoples; and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning hooks; nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war anymore.



# The 3 Millennial Camps

1. **Premillennialism** – Jesus will come back before the Millennium, and it will take place on earth.
2. **Postmillennialism** – Jesus will come back after the Millennium, and it will also take place on earth.
3. **Amillennialism** – The millennium is symbolically the time between the 1st and 2nd Coming of Christ, and consists of Christ reigning from heaven with his saints.



# Revelation 20:1-10

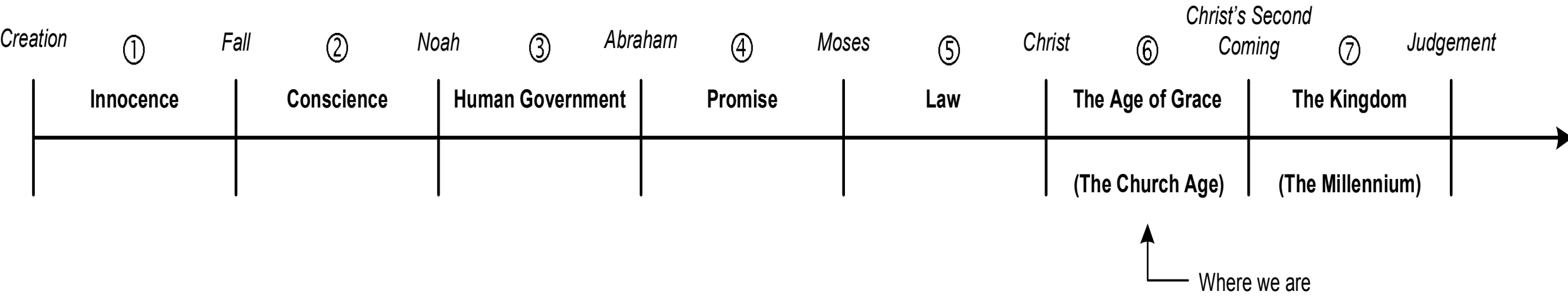
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## Key Events:

- 2 resurrections (vv. 4-5), and 2 deaths (vv. 4, 6)
- Satan is bound for 1,000 years (v. 2)
- Which coincides with 1,000 year reign of Christ (v. 4)
- After which, Satan is released to deceive the nations (vv. 7-8)
- For the purpose of fomenting a final, global assault on the saints (v.9)
- Whom God rescues, destroying all his enemies (vv. 9-10)

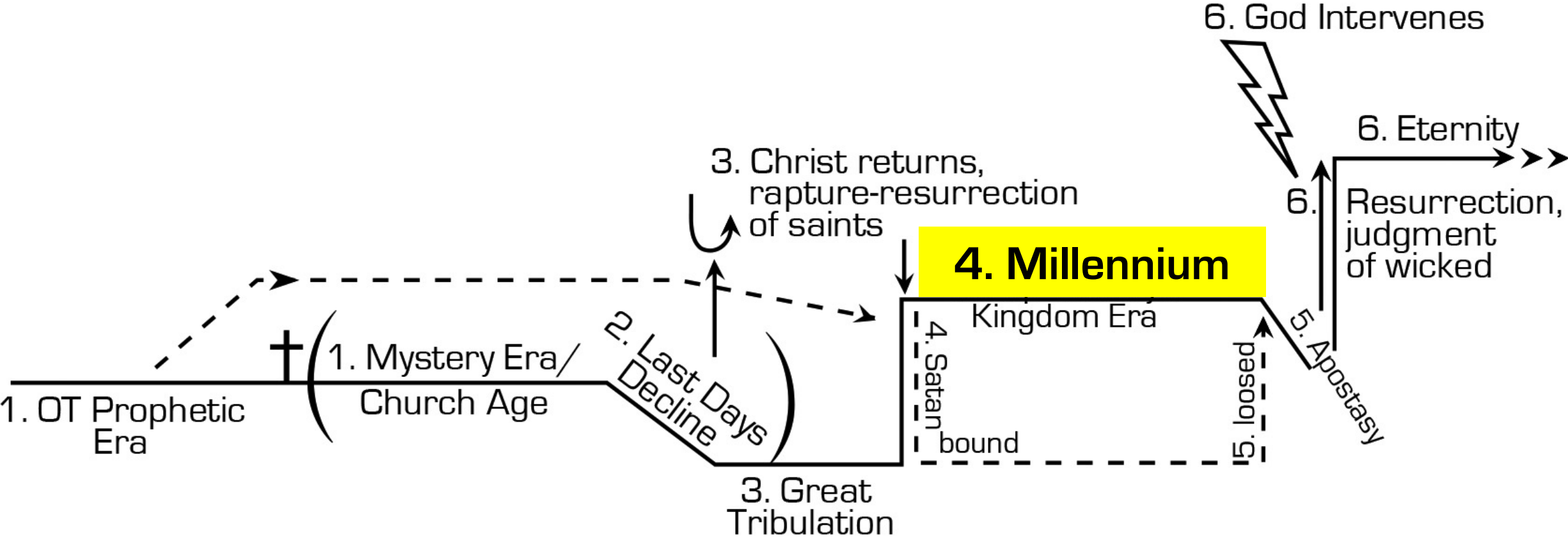

1. There are three Comings of Jesus, instead of two



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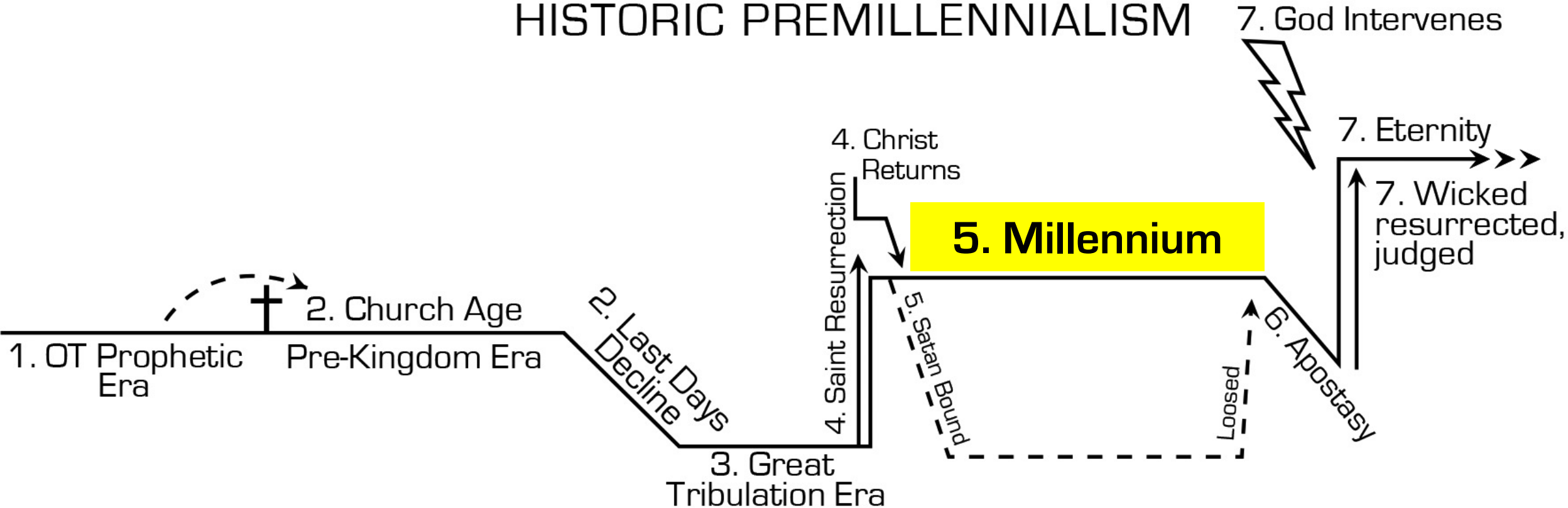
1. There are three Comings of Jesus, instead of two
2. It forever separates what God says he has joined (Jew & Gentile)
3. All the promises were to Abraham and his seed (Jesus). Jesus fulfilled them all. And the conditional promises were nullified by Israel's disobedience, so there is no need for a literal, future, Jewish-state-run millennium.



# One Key to Bible Interpretation

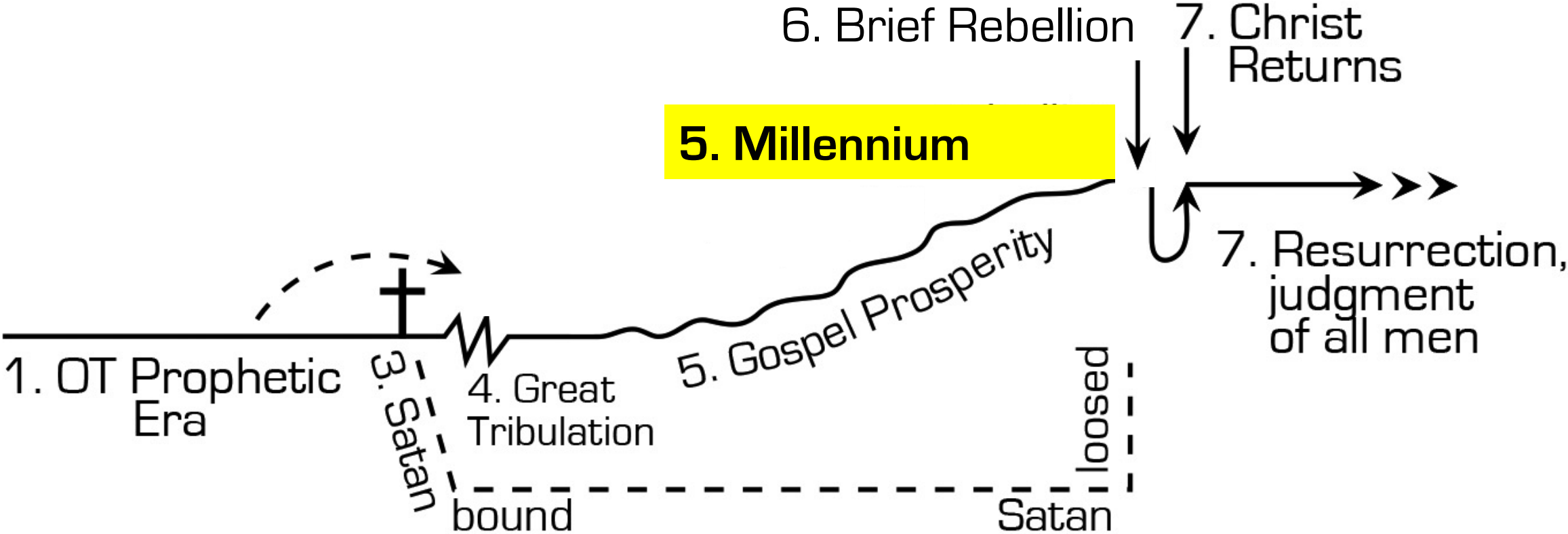


## 2 Thessalonians 1:5-8

# Problems with Postmillennialism

1. When Does Our Relief Come?
2. Revelation 19 & 20: Christ is coming back to an entire world that is poised to make war with him.
3. It redirects the “Blessed Hope” of the Christian away from Christ’s return, to an earthly utopia (still under the curse) in which Christ is not physically present.
