Battle Prayer must be:

Persistent •Spirit-dependent Scripture-shaped Exercised in community

Paul concludes his spiritual armor list to the Ephesians with battle prayer directives.

In view of our opposition as well as the gospel of Jesus, our prayers must be persistent, Spirit-dependent, Scriptureshaped, and exercised in community.

Read Ephesians 6:18-20 (page 979)

Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and, as shoes...put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace. In all circumstances take up the shield of faith...and take the <u>helmet</u> of salvation, and the <u>sword</u> of the Spirit, which is the word of God, praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert...

Praying at all times in the Spirit

Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words. And he who searches hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God.

(Romans 8:26-27)

Ephesians 3:16-19

that according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be strengthened with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith—that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.
