"...we now live in a time when consumer Christianity has become the accepted norm, and all-out engagement with and in Jesus' kingdom among us is regarded as just one option people may take if it suits them—but probably as somewhat "overdoing it." By contrast, the biblical pattern is, from beginning to end, "Be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only."

Read Ephesians 6:10-17 (page 979)

Ephesians 6:17b

...and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God

Word

Rhéma - utterance, for particular situation Logos - written word, or unchanging word

Exodus 24:3

Moses came and told the people all the words of the Lord and all the rules. And all the people answered with one voice and said, "All the words that the Lord has spoken we will do."

Acts 10:44

While Peter was still saying these things (ἡήματα, a form of "rhema"), the Holy Spirit fell on all who heard the word (λόγον, a form of "logos").

John 12:47-48

If anyone hears my words (rhema) and does not keep them, I do not judge him; for I did not come to judge the world but to save the world. The one who rejects me and does not receive my words (rhema) has a judge; the word (logos) that I have spoken will judge him on the last day.

Hebrews 4:12

For the word (logos) of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

2 Peter 3:5

For they deliberately overlook this fact, that the heavens existed long ago, and the earth was formed out of water and through water by the word (logos) of God.

Hebrews 11:3

By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word (rhema) of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things that are visible.

John 1:1

In the beginning was the Word (logos), and the Word (logos) was with God, and the Word (logos) was God.

Hebrews 1:3

He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word (rhema) of his power.

Matthew 4:4

But he answered, "It is written, "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God."

Revelation 1:16

Matthew 10:19-20
