"The World" 1. Defining the World

A. The World = Planet Earth

Romans 1:20

For [God's] invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse.

B. The World = Humanity

John 3:16

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

C. The World = Fallen World System

1 John 2:15

Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

C. The World = Fallen World System

- 1) To rebel and be autonomous from God, thus becoming their own gods
- 2) To redefine good and evil according to their own desires

John Mark Comer - Live No Lies

"A system of ideas, values, morals, practices, and social norms that are integrated into the mainstream and eventually institutionalized in a culture corrupted by the twin sins of rebellion against God, and the redefinition of good and evil."

1 John 2:16

For all that is in the world—the <u>desires of the flesh</u> and the <u>desires of the eyes</u> and <u>pride of life</u>—is not from the Father but is from the world.

The Forbidden Fruit in the Garden of Eden

- 1. "Good for food" (desire of the flesh)
- 2. "A delight to the eyes" (desire of the eyes)
- 3. "Desirable to make one wise" (the boastful pride of life)

2 Corinthians 4:4

John 17:14-18 Observations

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- There's a <u>natural hostility</u> that this world system has toward us.
- And that's because though we are in this world, we are not of it. We're strangers and aliens here.
- Jesus wants us in the world, protected from the evil one, and sanctified in the truth.

The Believer's Relationship to the World

He has been chosen <u>out</u> of it. (John 15:19, 17:6) Therefore he is not <u>of</u> the world (John 17:14-16)

He has been sent into the world (John 17:18)

Representatively, he is in it (John 17:11-15) to be a <u>light</u> in the midst of it (Matthew 5:14)

The Believer's Relationship to the World

He is not known in it (1 John 3:1)

He is not to be **conformed** to it (Romans 12:2)

He is not to be a **friend** of it (James 4:4)

He is told to <u>love not</u> the world (1 John 2:15) and to keep himself <u>unspotted</u> from it (James 1:27)

The Believer's Relationship to the World

He is by faith to <u>overcome</u> it (1 John 5:4)

Thus he will be **hated** by it (John 17:14)

Yet shall he **judge** it (1 Corinthians 6:2)

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2 Peter 2:8

...(for as that righteous man lived among them day after day, he was tormenting his righteous soul over their lawless deeds that he saw and heard);

Jim Elliott - missionary/martyr (1927-1956)
