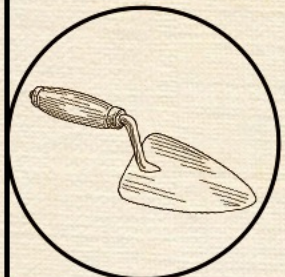


We each have unique harvest roles/gifts

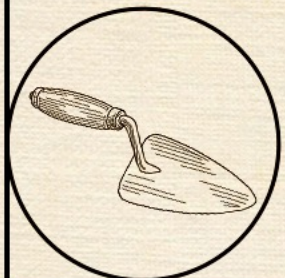


Hunger for Harvest Progress (Like Jesus)

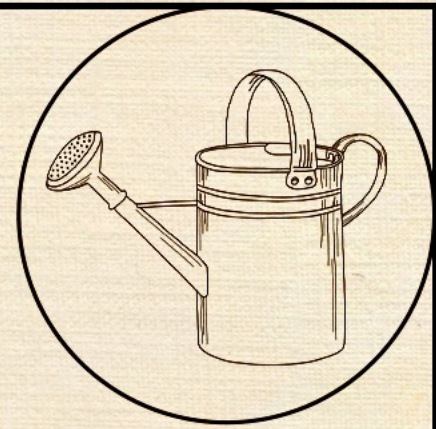

(John 4:31–34)

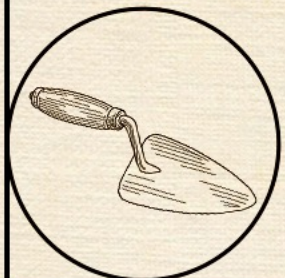

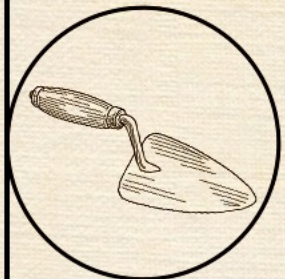


All rejoice in another's harvest progress

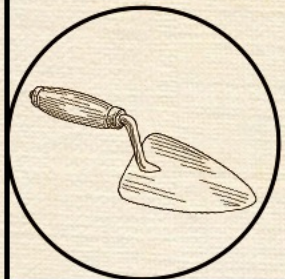




WATER Pledge Ideas



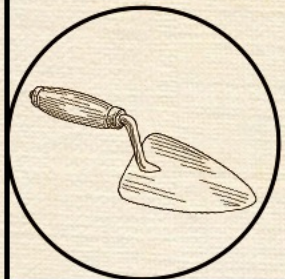
- Invite a missionary to share their story with you
