
And when we came into Rome, Paul was allowed to stay by himself, with the soldier who guarded him.




If death couldn't keep Jesus in the grave, then nothing can stop the gospel from advancing.

Paul could have said "I'm chained to these guards." Instead he realized: "They're chained to me."





And most of the brothers, having become confident in the Lord by my imprisonment, are much more bold to speak the word without fear.




2 Timothy 2:8-9


