
#### Background on Circumcision



#### Flesh: Human Effort/Works


- Rely on self for living life
- Crave personal credit > Jesus
- Trust in their effort/works

#### **Gospel: Dependent Living**

- Live dependent on Holy Spirit
- Treasure/give credit to Jesus
- Don't boast in accomplishment




