
Philippians 4:8-9

And all who heard it wondered at what the shepherds told them. But Mary treasured up all these things, pondering them in her heart.





What you have learned and received and heard and seen in me—<u>practice these things</u>, and <u>the</u> <u>God of peace will be with you</u>.




