Middle East Long-Term Missionaries	Six Summitview individuals intend to serve in various locations in the Middle East. One has arrived, with the other five planning staggered arrivals in 2026-28. Central Asia Long-Term Missionaries	Some of the most unreached peoples live in a cluster of countries in Central Asia.
